Lift Passes

There is really one decision to make when buying a lift pass – do you want to ski just the Les Arcs/ Peisey Vallandry area, or do you want to ski the full Paradiski area which includes La Plagne?

Snow Situations is superbly located so that either option is a good one!!



Les Arcs/ Peisey Vallandry Area:

As you can see from the above map, there is a LOT of skiing and we think it is the best ski area in the world!! There is about 200km's of marked pistes, endless gentle and epic off-piste areas.

There are spectacular views from the top of the Aigle Rouge at 3,226m altitude with a 7km run down to Villaroger. Despite the extensive area, its mountain formation means that if you are in a mixed group who like to venture to different areas, it is relatively simple to meet up within a lift or two.

I could go on about the amazing runs, snow parks, water slides and luge areas, but I want to leave some gems for you to discover too!

The 2nd Largest Linked Ski Area In The World:

The Paradiski area is simply paradise on snow!

The area is made up of three ski areas – Peisey Vallandry, Les Arcs and La Plagne. The most popular pass to buy is the “essential” pass that allows you unlimited access to the full area which is a whopping 425km of marked pistes and unlimited off-piste adventure.

The “essential” pass also provides access to 13 express lanes on the Les Arcs side – which usually means no queuing at these lifts even in the busiest weeks. This is the pass that we would usually recommend for any reasonable beginner level and particularly adventurous, mile hungry, intermediates and expert skiers and boarders.

This pass also gives you discounts on other activities such as the Zip Line, Toboggan, Illumination shows and the Aigle Rouge fast track.

One other option, usually suited to complete beginners where the bigger area is not required is the cheaper “Peisey Vallandry” pass. This can only be purchased in the lift pass offices on the day.

It has access to some really good quality Green, Blue and Red pistes and even 2 Black pistes, so there is no restricting your progression in any way and it is probably the quietest area in the Paradiski area and directly on our doorstep!
